Marita's husband gave her two children and HIV—then abandoned her. Ashamed and in abject poverty, Marita kept her head down to avoid eye contact with others in her Rwandan village.

Then Marita met a pastor trained by a Discipling for Development team in his community. He invited Marita into a discipleship group, where she learned her true worth in Christ. She also learned how to earn money selling at the market, and found she was good at it.

Now Marita owns a small parcel of land where she farms and has built a small house for her family. She's taught her children how to care for their own animals to pay for school supplies and other expenses.

Consider long-term D4D service among an unreached people group

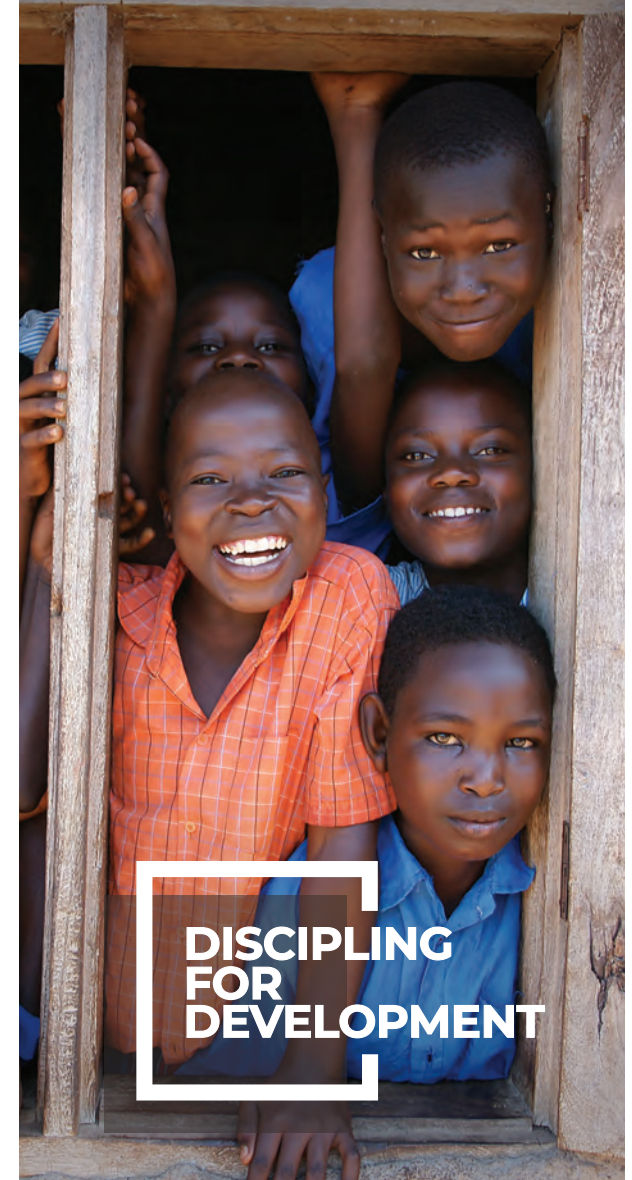
